Covid Safety Plan

July 14/21

1. Bowls Canada Boulingrin Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims and Indemnity

Agreement: A signed copy of this agreement must be on file at the club for all club members.

2. Symptom Assessment Form: Signing of a Symptom Assessment Form is no longer required each time a member/visitor enters the CLBC grounds. A sign will be posted at the entrance to the club grounds asking that any person having any signs of the virus such as fevers, chills, cough, shortness of breath, muscle aches, head aches or a sore throat not enter the club grounds to minimize possible transfer of the virus.

3. On-site registration: All members and visitors must sign their name in the registration book each time they enter the CLBC premises. This registration is required to ensure that tracking of all people who were at the club each day can be carried out if a person later shows virus symptoms or tests positive for the virus.

4. Self monitoring is in effect during all bowling activities as no designated Monitors will be assigned. It is recommended that a 1 metre separation distance be practiced when possible. It is also recommended that handshakes at the start and end of each game be put on hold for now.

5. Club House Activities:

- **Washrooms:** A maximum of two people are allowed in each of the washrooms at any one time. A mask is not required. Washroom surfaces will be sanitized at the start of each day.

- **Clubhouse:** No limit is set for the number of people in the clubhouse at any one time. Masks should be worn by members/visitors who are not yet **fully*** vaccinated.

- **Kitchen:** Up to four **fully*** vaccinated members of the Hospitality Committee are allowed to work in the kitchen at any one time.

6. Bowls/mats storage shed: Members entering the shed to get items from their lockers (no loitering, conversations should be held outside) are not required to wear masks. The shed is very open and when the roll up door is up, the area can be considered to be classed as "outdoors".

7. Equipment shed: Members entering the equipment shed to retrieve items such as lawn mowers or wheel barrows are not required to wear masks. If two or more members are going to work in the equipment shed (e.g. – sharpening mower blades, repairing equipment), masks are required for those not yet **fully*** vaccinated.

Please enjoy your Bowling under the relaxed rules and continue to BE SAFE.

BC Mask guidance July 1

Masks are recommended but not required in indoor public settings for all people 12 and older who are not yet fully vaccinated.
